Dear Parents,

As you are aware, our exciting new residential for Maple Class takes place on Monday 18th – Wednesday 20th May 2020. I am writing to confirm further details with you having met with a representative to finalise details and the cost.

The total cost is £113.00 per child. This includes the coach journeys, activities that are provided by the centre staff, accommodation and meals. The activities we have booked are: firelighting, shelter building, outdoor cooking, lowropes and a visit from a conservationist. School staff will take the children on a woodland walk which is part of the site. To cut down on costs, a member of school staff will be preparing breakfast and lunch. Caterers at the centre will cook a hot evening meal. Your child will need to bring a pillow and sleeping bag for their bedding.

You will have already paid a deposit of £20 which is non-refundable. The outstanding balance of £93.00 can be paid by:

- Cheque - make these payable to Appleshaw St.Peter's CE Primary School
- Online – through the 'school money' system
- Cash - a savings card will be held in the office in order that each payment is recorded

You may wish to pay in instalments. However, we would appreciate the total balance to be paid by 3rd April 2020.

If you would like your child to take part but are concerned about the cost, then we may be able to help. Please come and see me or Mrs Tilley if you would like a confidential discussion regarding this matter.

In the New Year, I will set a date for an information evening where I can give you the finer details, including a kit list and you can ask any questions that you need to. If there is anything that you would like to discuss prior to this, please don't hesitate to see me or Miss Yelland.
